The National Pro-Life Religious Council (NPRC) is a Christian coalition which acknowledges Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and is called to affirm and witness to the biblical standard of the value, dignity and sanctity of human life.

Vision

To see every Christian denomination or fellowship proclaim and obey Biblical teaching and Christian tradition that affirm the value of all human life.

Mission

- To articulate the historic Christian perspective concerning human life issues.
- To encourage efforts that discourage and prevent acts that dehumanize and harm women, the unborn, disabled persons, the elderly and those who are chronically ill.
- To encourage and foster ministry to those vulnerable to or wounded by such violence.
- To work cooperatively with others who share these goals.
